WORD ON THE WORD:

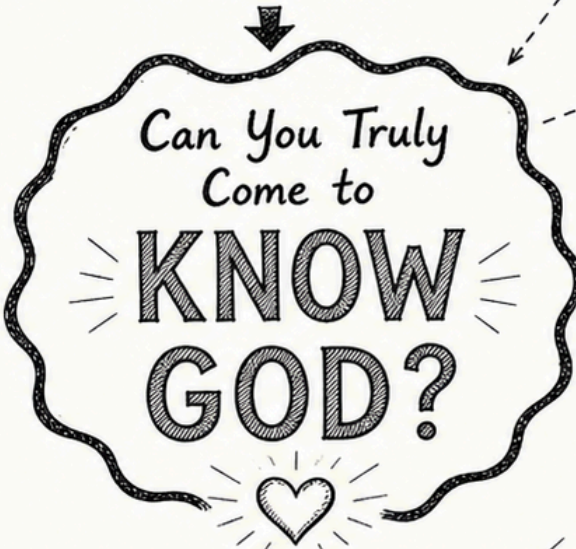

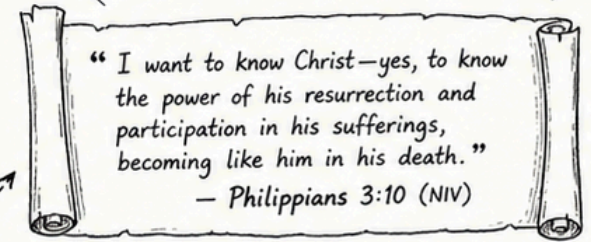
THREE KEY TRUTHS:

- ★ God may be beyond understanding, but He is not unknowable.

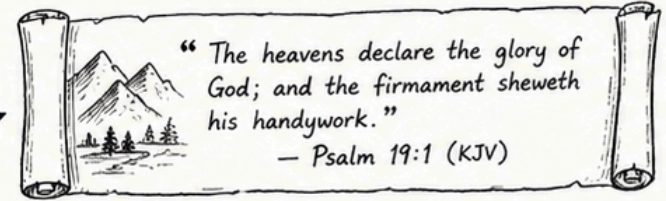


★ We don't figure God out. God makes Himself KNOWN.

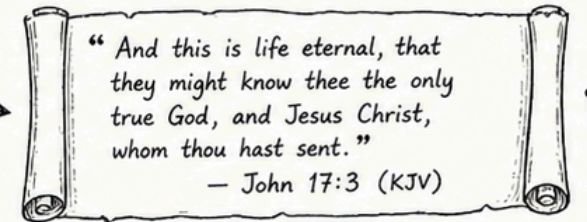
GOD REVEALS HIMSELF...

— Philippians 3:10 (NIV)

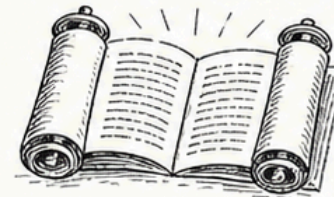

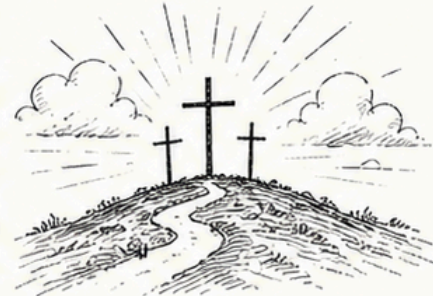
